- Perform and analyze transthoracic echocardiograms (12 patients per day)

- Generate preliminary reports and communicate findings with cardiologists
- Ensure patient comfort, safety, and dignity throughout examinations
- Maintain ultrasound equipment and perform routine QC documentation
- Maintain accurate patient records and reporting
- Follow clinic infection prevention and control procedures

- Minimum 1 year echocardiography experience preferred
